

2024 Highlights

The Foundation received 23 funding requests seeking \$174,090 and approved 17 grants totalling \$100,020.

Established the Foundation's 8th Named Fund: *The Rose Thomas Bouquet of Talent Fund*.

Raised over \$21k at the 1st Annual Norm Parry Memorial Golf Scramble.

Concluded an update of the Foundation's Strategic Plan, with focus areas of Fundraising, Communications and Governance.

Administered \$50k in Community Grant funds on behalf of the City of Terrace.

At year end, the combined value of the Terrace Community Foundation Endowment Fund and its 8 Named Funds is \$1.1 million.

2024 at a Glance

The **Terrace Community Foundation Board** started 2024 with updating our **Strategic Plan**. The original Strategic Plan was developed in 2018 and last updated in 2020, so we were due for a refresh. We maintained our three focus areas of Fundraising, Communications and Governance and adjusted our objectives.

Our **fundraising objective** is to increase the TCF Fund from approximately \$900,000 in late 2023 to \$1.3 million within 5 years (approx. \$75,000/year). We are pleased to report that we surpassed our fundraising objective in 2024 and added more than \$97,000 to our funds. 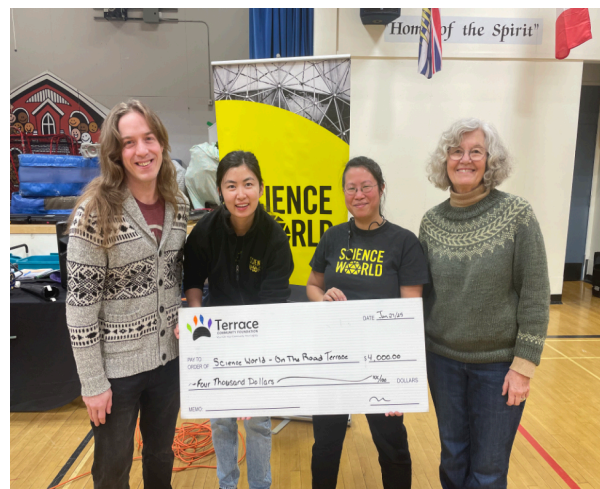
